The year 2025 we have seen our students excel academically, with exceptional results in board examinations and internal assessments. We are very happy to share the details of the commendable performances of our students. Senior Secondary and Secondary CBSE result was declared on 13th May 2024. We are happy to announce that in Senior Secondary level our School attained 100% result with all first Class. Total 57 students appeared and 77% students got distinction in various subjects. Master Adith R Lal was the topper of Science with 97% marks with A1 in all subjects and Master S Bhadradas was the topper of Commerce with 94.8% marks. In Secondary level grade 10 total 69 students appeared for the CBSE Board Examinations and we are glad to announce that in class 10th also we got 100% result with 77% distinction. Out of 69 students 96% students got first class. Miss P S Amaniya was the school topper with 96.4% marks and Shreya A with 94.4% with A1 in all subjects. Diya Viswam and Devananda R made us more proud by achieving centum for Malayalam.
