In today's educational landscape, academic excellence continues to be a hallmark of a school's success. Our students once again demonstrated exceptional performance in the CBSE AISSE 2023-24 examinations. Dadi Sansitha Gargi excelled with a perfect score in Mathematics, while Dharba Sai Lalith achieved a centum in Social Science. For the 18th consecutive year, we proudly celebrate a 100% pass rate, with outstanding distinctions and first-class results.

This accomplishment reflects the relentless dedication of our teachers, who inspire students to explore their potential and embrace lifelong learning. Among the standout achievers in the 2023-24 academic

session were Dharba Sai Lalith and Dadi Sansitha Gargi, both securing an impressive 95%. Shruti Vellala and Sai Kishore followed with 92.4%, while Kannikanti Meghana earned 92% and Baikan Anirudh scored 90.2%. In total, 59 students appeared ,7 secured A1 grades, with 38 achieving distinction , 17 earning first-class results and 5 achieving second class.

Infrastructure Development and Upgradation at Amrita Vidyalayam, Secunderabad

Amrita Vidyalayam, Secunderabad, is committed to providing a safe, modern, and well-equipped learning environment to enhance the academic and co-curricular experience of every student. In line with this vision, several significant infrastructure developments and upgrades have been undertaken recently.

1. Renovation of the Old Building

The old school building has undergone a complete renovation to ensure structural safety, aesthetic appeal, and functionality. The first and ground floors have been revamped with improved flooring, repainting, electrical fittings, and better ventilation to create a more conducive learning atmosphere for the students.

2. Upgradation of Washroom Facilities
